
# FIRST INTERNATIONAL BIART WORKSHOP

The workshop has as its main aim to analyze, discuss and generate debate on the key issues affecting cities under climate variability and change, as well as policies and opportunities for designing city climate action plans

The main purpose of this workshop is to focus on key aspects that frame dty plans to address climate change impacts and policy.
