# Pre-College Study Abroad Instructions for Students and Parents

Please complete and submit the following no later than **May 31, 2012**. All forms may be downloaded from <http://www.brown.edu/summer/forms> and should be faxed (401-863-3916) or mailed to Brown University Continuing Education, Attn: Forms Coordinator, Box T, Providence, Rhode Island 02912-9120.

7. Please send a copy of the photo page of your passport (passport must be valid at least 3 months after the end of the program).

**Please read these instructions carefully. Forms that are completed incorrectly will be returned to you and may affect your enrollment.**

**1. Pre-College Summer Abroad Student Acceptance Form **\*\*THIS IS A TWO-PAGE FORM\*\*****

Form is to be completed by the student if over 18 years of age and the parent or guardian if the student is under 18 years of age. Please complete the form - parent and student must sign pages 1 and 2.

**2. Medical Authorization Form **\*\*THIS IS A TWO-PAGE FORM\*\*****

Complete both sides of this form. The student and parent must sign page 2 of the form.

**3. Immunization History Form **\*\*THIS IS A TWO-PAGE FORM\*\*****

Please fill out the top. The remainder of this form is to be completed and signed by your medical provider.

**4. Disability & Medical Accommodations Form (if applicable)**

This form should be completed by any student who has a disability or medical condition that may require an accommodation: learning and/or physical including significant food allergies. Please be aware that all accommodation requests will be considered however there may be limits as to what can be provided without sufficient notice. Student and Employee Accommodations Services (SEAS) recommend a minimum of two weeks notice. The student and parent must sign the bottom of this form and submit directly to the SEAS Office (see form for fax and address).

- 5. As recommended by the CDC, students may meet with their respective physicians who will determine if vaccinations will be advised upon learning about the program's intended activities and destinations within the country of study, and keeping in mind the health histories of the student.**

## TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

- Confirmation of program status (which is based upon course enrollments and deposits paid) will be sent to students via email by April 15, 2012.
- Please do not submit full payment or purchase airfare until after your program has been confirmed.

## PASSPORT/VISAS

A passport is required for all students while traveling internationally. US and EU citizens do not require a visa to participate in these programs. Students who do not hold US or EU Passports must consult with the program country's Embassy to determine if they are required to obtain a student visa and other documentation required. The Office of Continuing Education will provide a letter of admission for students who request visa support.
